The Not One More Child Safety Education Initiative led by radKIDS, Inc. and The Joyful Child Foundation is a community model for prevention education. The Initiative partners train volunteers from community agencies to become certified instructors to provide ongoing prevention education for children and adults. The programs compliment community policing efforts as well as parental engagement, violence and bullying reduction programs in schools. Initiative Instructor Certification candidates include the following: law enforcement officers, teachers, recreation staff, passionate parents and volunteers as well as family resource providers and counselors. It takes a community to keep our children safe and ensure not one more child is victimized or taken.



For Children: radKIDS Personal Empowerment and Safety Education®

Endorsed by the National Sheriffs' Association, the radKIDS educational model is recognized as the national leader in safety education and violence prevention for children. radKIDS (501c3) is the largest instructor-based children's safety organization in the country with over 4500 trained instructors in 47 states. In 12 years radKIDS has taught these life skills to 165,000 children. To date, 65 children have documented escaping attempted abduction and thousands have gotten away from bullying, violence and sexual assault. www.radKIDS.org
